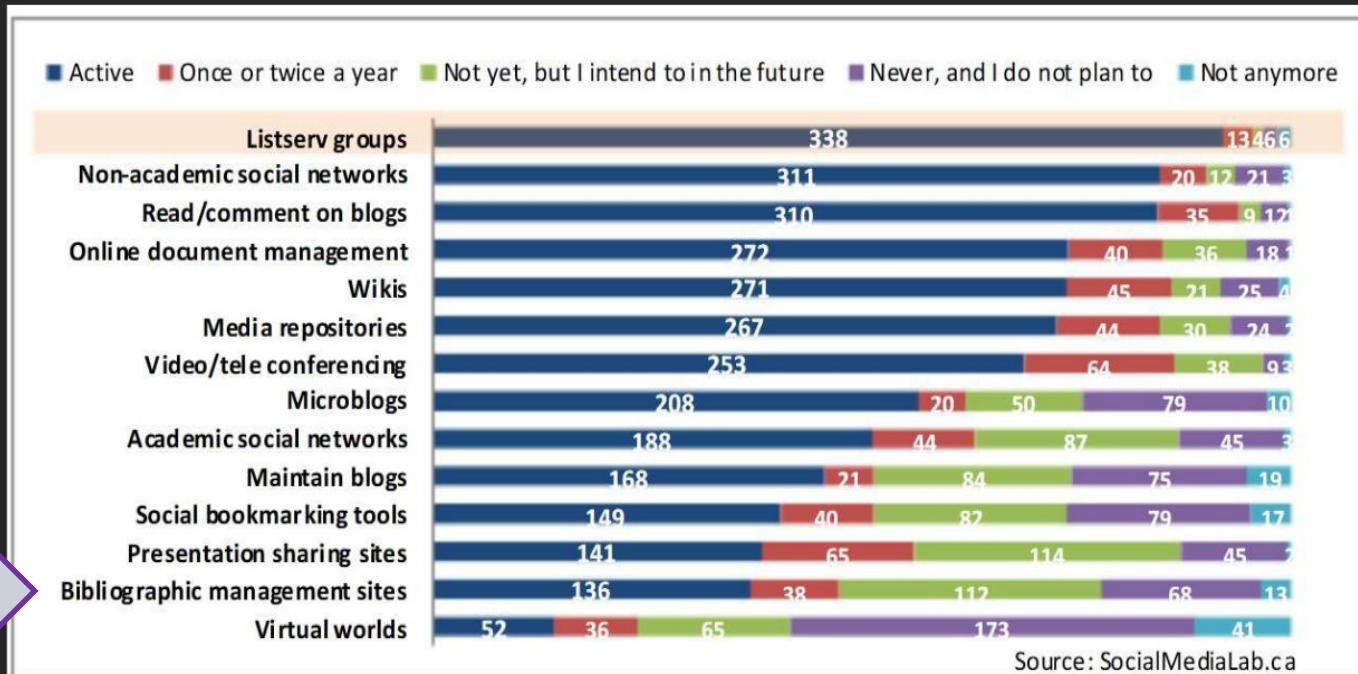


Figure 1. Ranking of Social Media Based on the Frequency of Use in Academic Communities for Professional Purposes

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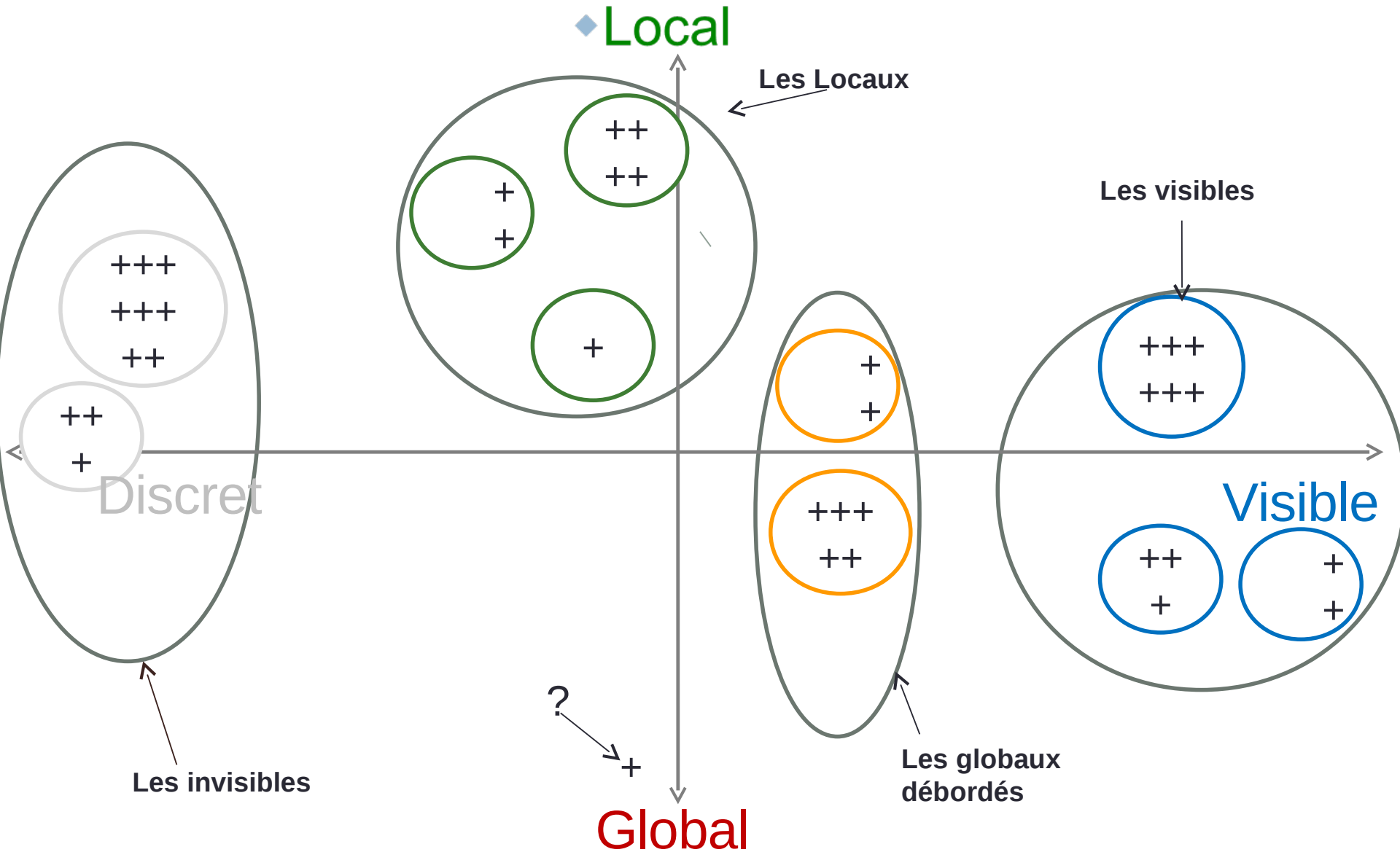

Mendeley : principes et spécificités 2.0

Principes : logiciel bibliographique

- Collecter et gérer les références bibliographiques
 - des documents nécessaires pour la rédaction de bibliographies
 - de ses **propres travaux**, pour les valoriser.
- Automatisation
 - de la collecte et de la saisie des références collecter sur Internet (Sc direct, Springer, Web of Science, Econlit, Repec, Google Scholar),
 - du rapatriement et de la saisie des pdf localisés sur votre ordinateur
 - de la mise à jour de vos publications sur la web
 - de la rédaction de vos bibliographies (Word, Open Office, LaTeX, Lyx,...)

Principes : 2.0 & réseau sociaux

- Logiciel téléchargeable gratuitement mais non libre (propriétaire).
- Double interface : données sur son poste et dans le « Cloud »
- Web & réseau : Gérer et partager les références bibliographiques, afficher ses travaux, se regrouper par affinité

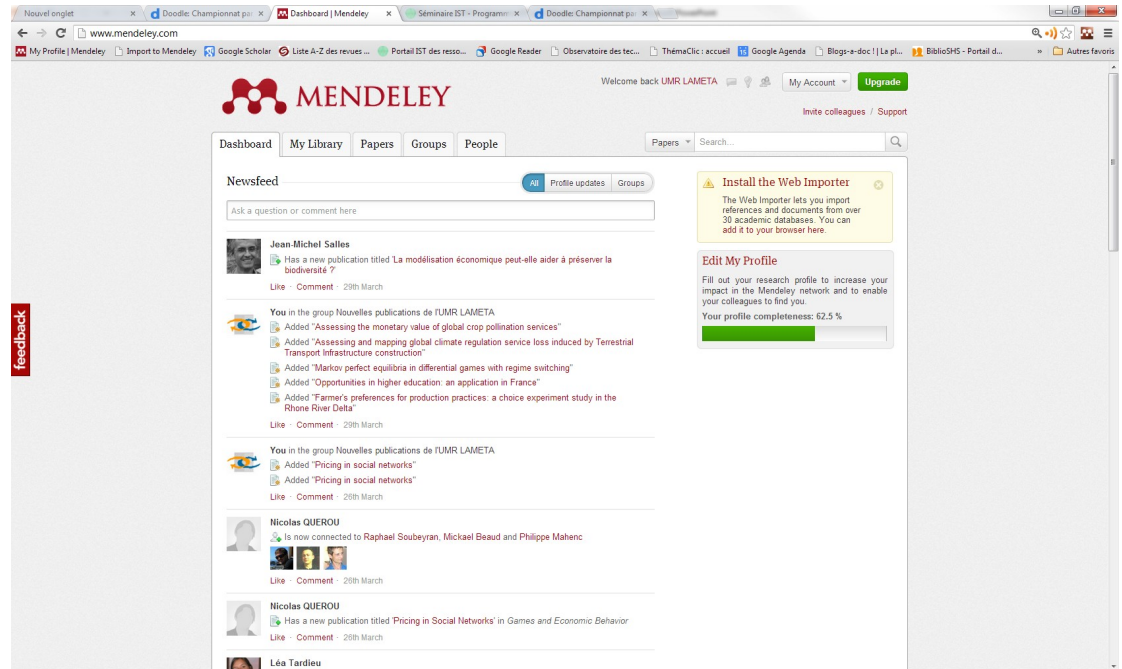

Abstract

Assuming that a North-South transfer is the key to effective climate cooperation, we ask when and how much the North should offer to the South in return for a commitment to reduce deforestation and forest degradation. In light of the risk of irreversible damage over time, we examine a negotiation with a deadline. In this case, the North threatens the South over a negotiation deadline in case an agreement is not reached rapidly. We assess the conditions for an agreement to be immediate or delayed, and discuss those situations likely to result in negotiation failure. 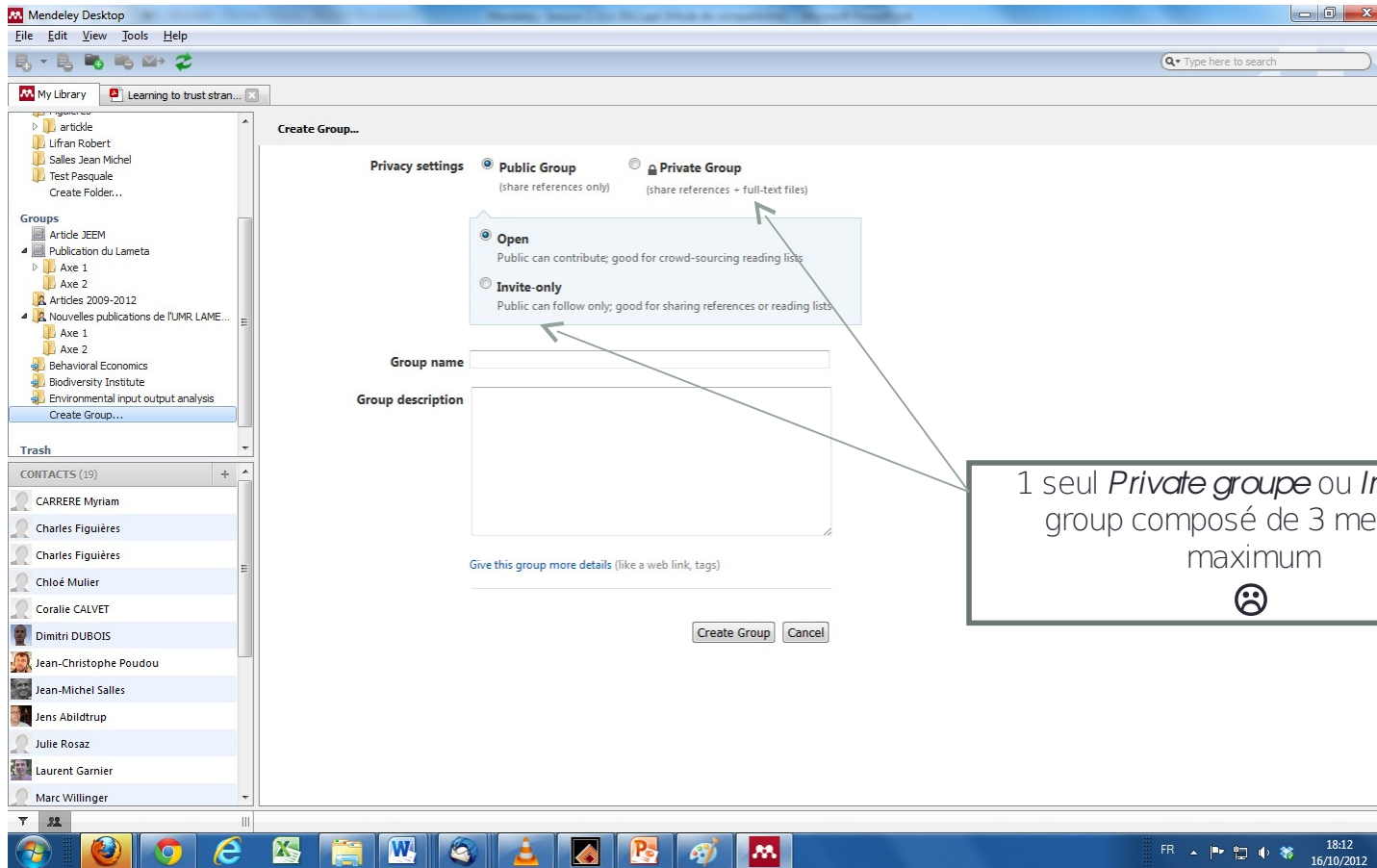

L'UMR en contacts

- Nombre de « Contacts » : de 1 à 33 contacts (→ 13 en moyenne)
- Principalement des Contacts entre membres de l'UMR
 - Les contacts extérieurs ne représentent que 6% des contacts noués
 - Plus de la moitié des membres n'ont aucun contacts hors UMR
- Un seul chercheur semble avoir une « démarche contacts » : 1/3 des contacts hors UMR (→ professeur reconnu dans son domaine)

- Des chercheurs encore peu sensible aux apports des réseaux sociaux pour la recherche
- Instabilité et avenir du logiciel Mendeley
